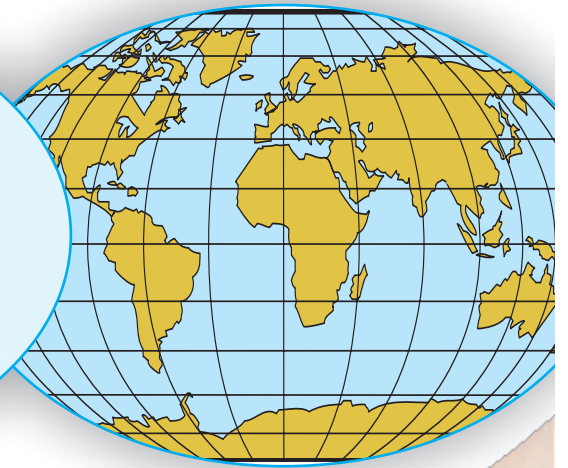

All kinds (including the Arctic Circle)
100 miles by land (see related notes: Des, salt, waterways, rivers, etc.), including the segments from Paris to Dakar and from North to South America through the Andes Mountains

23 top rivers (Nile, Ganges, Congo, etc.)
Climates:
The March will pass through all climate, from cold and temperate — passing through Mediterranean, continental, tropical, and desert zones — to polar, from the tundra/steppes through the Sahel desert and the Nazam Desert (the driest in the world) to Antarctica.
Seasons:
In 90 days the March will pass winter through all 4 seasons of the year
Altitude:
During the journey the March will climb to altitudes of more than 14,000 feet (4,300 meters)
Personnel: 20,000 marchers
Gender: 50% women
Co-organizing institutions: 500
Collaborating and supporting institutions: 100
Worldwide government and political representatives: 100
Spiritual leaders: 25
Participants in the first: 1 million
Virtual participants: 10 million

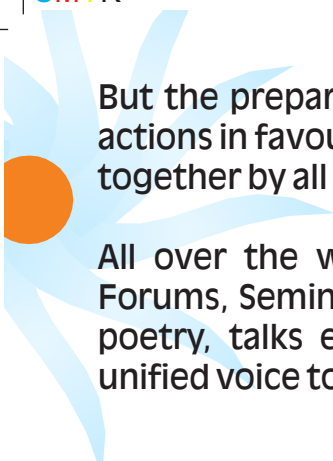
